

Prescribed Forms (Customs Arrival Information) Notice 2024

Under rule 3 of the Customs (Arriving Passenger and Crew Declarations) Rules 2018 as amended on 28 March 2024 (the **Rules**), I, Christine Stevenson, Comptroller of Customs, make this notice.

Customs Arrival Information may be provided in the following ways:

- a) For passengers arriving by air:
 - i. electronically via the New Zealand Traveller Declaration (**NZTD**) system; or
 - ii. by paper form in the New Zealand Passenger Arrival Card; or
 - iii. by paper form in the NZTD paper declaration (air).
- b) For passengers and crew members arriving by sea:
 - i. electronically via the NZTD system; or
 - ii. by paper form in the New Zealand Passenger Arrival Card; or
 - iii. by paper form in the NZTD paper declaration (maritime); or
 - iv. by paper or electronic format in the Crew (Temporary Arrivals – Cruise) Form (Form 18), if the person is a crew member arriving by cruise ship who is departing with the same ship on its next departure from New Zealand.

- The NZTD paper declaration (air), the NZTD paper declaration (maritime), and the Crew (Temporary Arrivals – Cruise) Form (Form 18) are available on the Customs website at www.customs.govt.nz.

Commencement – This notice comes into effect on 28 March 2024.

Revocation – The notice titled ‘Prescribed Form for providing Customs Arrival Information’, dated 7 December 2023, is revoked (on the date this notice comes into effect).
